Writing Tools

#2 Pencils (12–24 pack) – For writing, math, and standardized tests.

Mechanical Pencils (optional) – For neat and consistent writing.

Erasers (large or pencil-top) – To make clean corrections.

Blue, Black, and Red Pens (2–3 each) – For writing, editing, and marking assignments.

Highlighters (3 colors) – To mark key points in notes and textbooks.

Notebooks & Paper

College-Ruled Spiral Notebooks (5) – One for each major subject.

Composition Notebook (1) – For English or journaling.

Loose-Leaf College-Ruled Paper (1–2 packs) – For classwork and extra notes.

Pocket Folders (5–6, assorted colors) – To organize homework and papers by subject.

Project & Study Supplies

Glue Stick (1–2) – For small projects or presentations.

Scissors (student-safe) – For cutting materials.

Ruler (12-inch, inches and centimeters) – For geometry or science tasks.

Index Cards (1–2 packs) – For studying and research notes.



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
